



A REPORT ON DIPLOMA IN TRAVEL AND TOURISM MANAGEMENT

Name of the course: Diploma in Travel and Tourism Management (DTTM)

Duration: the tenure of the course is for one year

Year of Introduction: Admission started from 15th December onwards; Notice: one month in advance of the course will be by 1st week of January, 2014.

Introduction:

Responding the proposal submitted by Pub Kamrup College for Career Oriented Courses (Add-on), the UGC approved two courses namely Tourism and Medical Laboratory Technician courses from the academic year 2013-14. For these courses UGC has sanctioned a sum of Rs. 17,00,000 (seventeen lakhs) only as Seed Money Vide UGC letter No. 4-98/2013 (COC) dated 31/03/2013; of which seven lakhs for Tourism and 10 lakhs for Medical Laboratory Technician course.

Objectives:

1. The objective of the scheme is to introduce career and market oriented, skill-enhancing add-on courses that have utility for job, self employment and empowerment of the students.
2. At the end of three years, the students will be equipped with a Diploma in an add-on orientation course along with a conventional degree in Science/Arts/Commerce.
3. The courses offered here of interdisciplinary in nature and the students will have the freedom to diversify into various fields not necessarily related with their core discipline.
4. This will provide opportunities to the students to undertake advanced studies and practice in the field of tourism.

Eligibility: 12th class passed with 50% marks or H.S. in any stream (Arts/Science/Commerce). History and Geography in H.S. is preferred subjects for the course but having the subjects is not mandatory for the course.

Seats: total intake capacity in one year is 20 students only

Admission: Admission of the course will be on merit basis with minimum 50% aggregate at HS level

Library: Books relating to the course have been purchased and are kept in the Central Library as well as Departmental Library.

Examination: The examination of the said course will be held as per the Gauhati University's examination Schedule. The first batch of the DTTM is going to appear their end term examination in June, 2015

Job Opportunities: Tourism is regarded as sun rising industry and termed as the most employment intensive industry. Job opportunities here are limited. The various job opportunities are in travel agencies, tour operators, car rental companies, hospitality sector, etc., besides as own account workers as Guide, Escort, Tour Package Designer etc. A tourist support service provider i.e. Visa, Travel Insurance etc along with the noble profession as entrepreneur by setting up own travel agency, restaurant, etc.

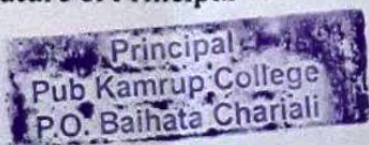
