- 2. Authors should use Times New Roman, 12pt font-size and lines must be double spaced for submissions in English. Gitanjali light, 14pt font-size should be adhered to, for submissions in Assamese.
- 3. An abstract of around **200-400** words along with keywords and a bio-note must accompany the submission.
- 4. MLA and APA style-sheet can be adhered to.
- 5. Word limit: **3000-4500** words including the Works Cited/ Reference section.
- 6. Book reviews should be within 1000-1200 words.
- 7. Submissions must be made in .docx and pagemaker format.
- 8. No publication fee will be charged for the first issue.
- 9. The journal will follow a blind peer-review system. Articles submitted elsewhere or considered for publication in any other journal, will **not** be considered here. We are strictly against simultaneous submissions.
- 10. Authors will be communicated about the status of their paper through their valid e-mail ID.
- 11. A '**Declaration by Author**' has to be sent by the contributor, along with his/her article, vouching for the authenticity and originality of their research work.
